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## ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT OF THE PLAINTIFF AGAINST DEFENDANTS AND ORDER DISMISSING COUNTER COMPLAINT OF JEFF TURNBOW FOR FAILURE TO STATE A CAUSE OF ACTION AND GRANTING RELIEF REQUESTED IN ORIGINAL COMPLAINT FOR PARTITION

This matter came to be heard on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of November, 2017, before the Honorable James F. Butler, Chancellor of the Chancery Court of Henderson County, Tennessee, upon the Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment, Affidavit in Support of Motion for Summary Judgment, Statement of Undisputed Facts, pro-se Answers of Defendants to original Complaint, (Defendants filed no response to Motion for Summary Judgment or Motion to Dismiss) statements of counsel and upon the entire record from all of which the Court is of the opinion that the Motion for Summary Judgment should be granted in this cause for the Plaintiff against the Defendants as there are no genuine issues of material fact, and that the Plaintiff is entitled to judgment in her favor as a matter of law. The Court is of the opinion that the Plaintiff's Motion to Dismiss the Counter Complaint of Jeff Turnbow for Failure to State a Cause of Action should be granted, and Motion for Sanctions will be taken under advisement and deferred. The Court further finds as follows:

1. That the property in this cause is so situated that it is not proper for partition in kind and that it is in the interest of all parties that property be sold for division.

2. That Clerk and Master be appointed Special Commissioner to carry out the terms of the sale and to otherwise dispose of property according to law.

3. Any existing debts, the cost of this cause, including attorney fees, surveying cost, Clerk's commission, and publication cost be taxed as cost and shall be paid from the proceeds of the sale, and the remaining proceeds be distributed to parties as their interest shall appear.

4. That a surveyor be employed if necessary to survey the property and prepare plats.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

1. That the Motion for Summary Judgment filed by Plaintiff against the Defendants, and the Motion to Dismiss the Counter Complaint of Defendant, Jeff Turnbow, heretofore filed by the Plaintiff is hereby granted. Motion for Sanctions will be taken under advisement and deferred for later ruling.

2. That the property in this cause be sold for division.

3. That Clerk and Master be appointed Special Commissioner to carry out the terms of the sale and to otherwise dispose of property according to law.

4. Any existing debts, the cost of this cause, including attorney fees, surveying cost, Clerk's commission, and publication cost be taxed as cost and shall be paid from the proceeds of the sale, and the remaining proceeds be distributed to parties as their interest shall appear.

5. That a surveyor be employed if necessary to survey the property and prepare plats.
